The Southville Centre is a 20 minute walk from the city centre (the hub of Bristol's Bus service). Bristol Temple Meads to the the Southville Centre is 1.6 miles (32 mins approx).

How to get to the Southville Centre

The Southville Centre enjoys a central location in Bristol, just south of the New Cut of the River Avon and only a mile from the City Centre. It is within easy reach on foot, by bike and by bus from the City Centre, Bristol Temple Meads Station, and the CREATE Centre.

On Foot

The Southville Centre is a 20 minute walk from the city centre (the hub of Bristol's bus service). From the cascade waterfall at the centre, follow the left bank of the docks past the Arncliffe Arts Centre to the swing bridge on Wapping Road. Cross the bridge and follow the road to a mini roundabout beside the Louisiana Pub. Turn right and follow the road alongside the New Cut of the Avon River to the traffic lights and cross over the pedestrian bridge (Gaul Ferry Bridge). Look out for Herons, Cormorants and Kingfishers. Cross at the traffic lights and continue into Dean Lane, almost directly opposite you. Take the first right into Stackpool Road, continue past Southville Primary School and take a right into Beauley Road, and then the Southville Centre.

Walking distances & times

- n Temple Meads to the Southville Centre: 1.6 miles (32 mins*, 10 mins**)
- n Council House to the Southville Centre: 1.1 miles (22 mins*, 9 mins**)
- n Create Centre to the Southville Centre: 0.9 miles (18 mins*, 7 mins**)
- n Bedminster Parade to Southville Centre: 0.6 miles (12 mins*, 6 mins**)

* assumes a gentle walking pace of 3 miles per hour
** assumes a gentle cycling pace

By Bike

The Southville Centre provides bike racks outside the centre and encourages visitors to cycle where possible. Cycle lanes connect the city centre to Coronation Road via Gaul Ferry bridge, and it is an easy cycle along quiet roads from there to the centre. Please see the times & distances above. At a steady pace it takes 6 mins to cycle to the city centre, 10 mins to Temple Meads and 7 mins to the CREATE centre.

By Bus

The Number 25 bus passes the Southville Centre in both directions every half hour during the day. Journey time to the city centre is about 15 minutes.

Other buses that stop close to the Southville centre include the following.

- 24 Lockleaze to Ashton Vale. Closest stop North Street (5 mins walk)
- 75 Gloucester Road to Whitchurch Lane,
- 76 Southmead to Hartcliffe,
- 77 Henbury to Hartcliffe. Closest stop West Street by London Inn. (7 mins walk)
- 500 Baltic Wharf Loop which connects Cumberland Road - Temple Meads, Centre, Clifton and Hotwells.

Don't forget that many Bristol buses stop in the city centre, which is only 20 minutes walk to the Southville Centre.

By Car

The Southville Centre is within easy reach of the M32, M5, A370 and A38. There is a small car park at the centre, which includes designated spaces for disabled drivers and for Car Club users. Additional parking can be found on residential streets. The management committee encourages visitors to use alternative means of travel or car-sharing where possible as traffic and parking places considerable pressure on the local community.
